EASTERN offers the following 14 career and technical programs to Eastern Montgomery County high school juniors and seniors:

- **Allied Health** – Prepares college-bound high school seniors for a career in the health field. Provides clinical experience at Abington-Jefferson.
- **Automotive Technology** – Covers computerized diagnostic techniques, engines, fuel systems, electrical systems, transmissions, clutches, brakes, front and rear suspension, air conditioning, and routine service procedures.
- **Business and Technology Professional** – Prepares students for a career in a professional office environment. Students study Microsoft Office applications, and other communication technologies. Dual enrollment with MCCC available.
- **Collision Repair Technology** – Includes automotive refinishing techniques, color mixing, painting and structural repairs.
- **Commercial Art** – Provides creative and technical instruction that includes drawing, design, color theory, digital imaging and basic photography, varied media, and computer arts, using industry-standard equipment.
- **Computer Network Administration** – Prepares first year students to pass the Certified Linux Administrator (CLA) exam as well as the Cisco CCENT in the second year. Dual enrollment with MCCC available.
- **Construction Technology** – Curriculum includes blueprint reading, planning and estimating along with experience in the installation of formwork, framing, finishing and stair, rafter and roof construction.
- **Cosmetology** – Prepares students to take the Pennsylvania State Board of Cosmetology exam upon completion of the required 1,250 hours.
- **Culinary Arts** – Focuses on creative and technical skills needed in the preparation of soups and sauces, entrees, baking, kitchen sanitation, purchasing and inventory controls.
- **Electrical Technology** – Provides training in residential, commercial, and light industrial electrical applications, as well as data cabling and fiber optic installation.
- **Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning** – Provides an understanding of gas laws, pressure/temperature relationships, proper use of tools, electricity needed for the service technician, and an introduction to hydronics.
- **Protective Services** – Provides a multi-disciplined program developed in consultation with county-wide advisory committees of law enforcement, fire science and security professionals, and post-secondary institutions.
- **Veterinary Science** - Provides the opportunity to pursue a career in the animal care industry, and gives students a working knowledge of small animal industries.
- **Welding Technology** – Covers properties of different types of metals and how to join them, blueprint reading, fabrication, testing, inspection and quality control.
