Allied Health

- This program is offered to high school seniors who are interested in continuing their education after high school in a health field. School districts in Eastern Montgomery County support this program and provide transportation to EASTERN.
- Two days a week students will receive extensive clinical experiences at Abington Memorial Hospital.
- Three days a week at EASTERN, student course work will include being dually enrolled with Montgomery County Community College which will afford them the opportunity to earn 3 college credits as part of the Allied Health Program. This program's course work will also include an introduction to Anatomy and Physiology, Patient Care Skills, Taking Vital Signs, CPR/AED/First Aid for Health Care Providers Certified, Infection Control and Management, Legal and Ethical Principles in Medicine.
- You receive credit toward graduation from your high school for taking this program at EASTERN. You also receive an EASTERN certificate if you complete all your career objective tasks with better than 70%.

Prerequisites for this program

- eligible for acceptance into a post secondary school
- Algebra I and II, College Prep Biology and Chemistry
- High school GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Physical exam and police check mandated by State Law
