- read and understand technical information

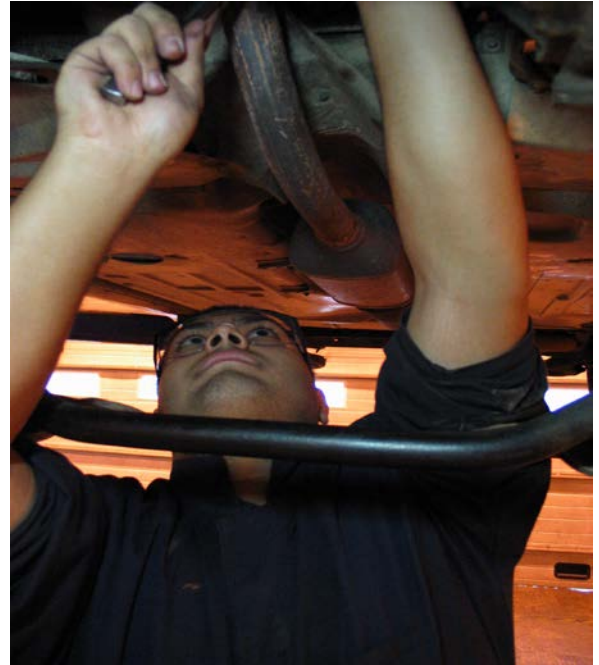
After completing this program you can
