- keep your skills current and acquire new ones

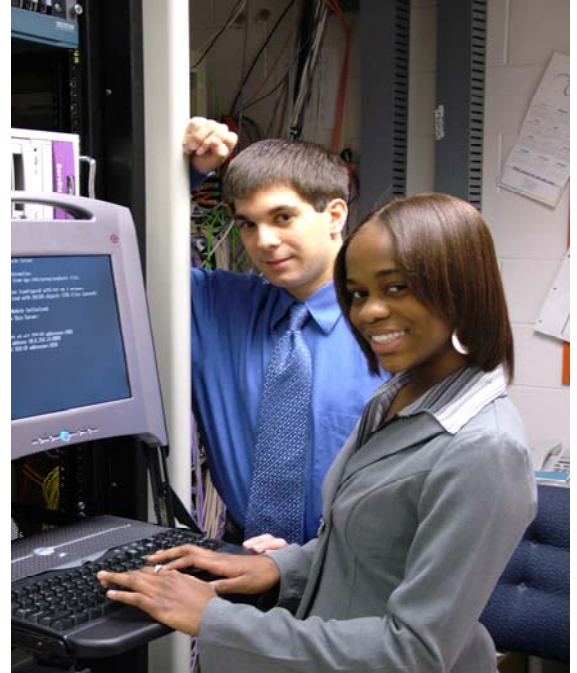
