Cosmetology

- EASTERN's cosmetology program is approved by the PA State Board of Cosmetology.
- The State Board of Cosmetology requires students to complete 200 hours of study before taking Nail Technician written and performance exams, and 1,250 hours (includes Nail Technician hours) before taking the Cosmetologist written and performance exams.
- This program is for high school junior and seniors. School districts in Eastern Montgomery County support the program and provide transportation to EASTERN.
- At the end of the first year, cosmetology students at EASTERN are required to pass the State Board of Cosmetology written/performance test for licensure as a Nail Technician in order to have their hours reported to the State Board of Cosmetology in the second year.
- You receive graduation credit from your high school for taking this program at EASTERN. IF you complete all your career objective tasks with a 70% or better you also earn an EASTERN certificate!
- The public is invited to our Cosmetology Clinic on most Thursdays and Fridays when second year cosmetology students provide salon services to practice on clients under the direction of a cosmetology teacher.

- keep up-to-date with new products & skills in the field
