Protective Services

- This program is for high school junior and seniors only in Eastern Montgomery County. It is offered in partnership with your high school and your school district provides transportation to EASTERN.
- You receive graduation credit from your high school for taking this program at EASTERN. IF you earn a 70% or better and complete all your career objective tasks you will also receive an EASTERN certificate.
- You can prepare for a career related to law enforcement, fire science, industrial safety and security and emergency radio dispatch.
- You can earn the following certifications: Exterior Evolutions and Hazardous Materials Awareness through testing by the Bucks County Fire Academy; Adult CPR and Standard First Aid through testing by the Red Cross; and the Police Dispatcher Certification.
- You will learn to use the same equipment used by professionals in the field and follow industry standards.
