## Veterinary Science

- This program is for high school juniors and seniors in Eastern Montgomery County. It is offered in partnership with your high school, and your school district provides transportation to EASTERN.
- You receive graduation credit from your high school for taking this program at EASTERN. If you complete all your career objective tasks and earn a 70% or better, you also can earn an EASTERN certificate!
- Veterinary Science is a Pennsylvania Department of Education-approved Tech Prep program. Students enrolled in this high priority occupation program are expected to take college prep academics as well as excel at their technical studies to qualify for advanced credits, reduced fees, or advanced standing at post-secondary institutions with which we have articulation agreements.
- Students enrolled in the Veterinary Science program will prepare for post-secondary education in Veterinary Sciences or employment in careers in a veterinary hospital, pet and pet supply store, grooming salons, kennel, animal humane societies, farms and ranches.
