

## REQUIRED MATERIALS FOR CLASS

The following supplies and documentation are required to complete the COMPUTER NETWORK ADMINISTRATION course:

### Second Year Students

- Cisco CCENT exam-approx. \$155.00
- Microsoft Server Certification-approx. \$85.00
- MCCC Dual Enrollment (optional)
  - 2-three credit courses approx. \$190.00 each

COMPUTER NETWORK ADMINISTRATION is a dual enrollment program. You can earn up to 12 college credits from Montgomery County Community College (MCCC) at 1/3 the cost of regular student tuition plus books. These credits transfer to most major colleges and universities. While in the Dual Enrollment program, you may also take additional courses, for even more credits. You will also have the opportunity to obtain industry certifications in this program.

We also have an agreement with Penn State Abington that any qualified student from this program will be given preferential admission into their four year major in Information Sciences and Technology (IST) and the admissions application cost will be paid for by Penn State Abington.
